NOTICE TO PROBATE ATTORNEYS

PROBATE MEDIATOR BINDERS

The Superior Court of California, County of San Diego has created a new Probate Mediator Packet (PKT-037) and is now accepting completed forms from probate, trust and/or estate planning mediators interested in having their individual Probate Mediator Profile included in binders to be made available to parties and attorneys in the probate courtrooms and Probate Business Offices at the Madge Bradley courthouse in the Central Division and at the Vista courthouse in the North Division.

The individual Probate Mediator Profile form (PR-152) requests detailed information about each mediator, including education, specialization, probate and other relevant experience, mediation training and experience, fees and language capabilities. To participate, mediators will also submit an executed Probate Mediator Certification and Release of Liability form (PR-152A) and thereby agree to serve on a pro bono basis for at least one case per year, not to exceed eight hours.
